Forest-related contributions of countries

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To date a total of 109 countries (counting the EU as one) have made statements regarding their willingness to reduce emissions from deforestation and forest degradation, or to enhance forest carbon stocks. Table C.1 gives an overview of national statements from the following efforts:

- *Contributions under UNFCCC:*
 - Intended Nationally Determined Contributions (INDCs), conditional or unconditional, submitted by 1 October 2015 (UNFCCC, 2015).
 - Nationally Appropriate Mitigation Actions (NAMAs): Several countries include quantitative information on anticipated forest-related mitigation activities, in hectares or in carbon terms (UNFCCC, 2014a, 2014b, 2014c).
- *Bilateral arrangements:* Donors (including Norway and Germany) have agreements with Brazil, Ethiopia, Guyana, Indonesia, Liberia, Ecuador, and Peru to provide funding conditional upon demonstrated success in contributing to mitigation through REDD+ ('results-based payments'). Other donors have made or are negotiating similar bilateral agreements.
- *Carbon Fund:* Proposals for reductions as documented in ER-PINs (FCPF, 2015).
- *International multi-stakeholder partnerships:* The New York Declaration on Forests (United Nations, 2014) and Bonn Challenge commitments on forest landscape restoration (Bonn Challenge, 2015).

As described in chapter 6, countries have outlined their forest mitigation contribution in varying detail. Some contributions are conditional, other unconditional. Table C.1 shows countries that have specifically included the forest sector in their mitigation scope in one or several of these communications, specifying whether the contribution is through reduced emissions from deforestation or forest degradation, enhancement of forest carbon stocks, or both. In some cases, activities were not specified. (Note: the Table excludes contributions from agroforestry and enrichment plantings, but includes statements on restoration of degraded forest lands. In some

INDCs, where forests were included in the mitigation scope but activities not described, descriptions of forest related activities in the adaptation section of the INDC were instead taken into account.)

Blue cells: The forest contribution specifies activities for emission reductions (ER)

Yellow cells: The forest contribution specifies activities for enhancement of forest carbon stocks (EN)

Green cells: The forest contribution specifies activities for both ER and EN
